Wimbledon School of English Course Dates 2027

[1] Courses starting in the week of a UK public holiday will start on the Tuesday instead of Monday.

Holiday dates for 2027 are Friday 01 January, Friday 26 March, Monday 29 March, Monday 03 May, Monday 31 May and Monday 30 August.

The school closes for Christmas and New Year on Friday 17 December and re-opens on Tuesday 04 January 2028. Please note that there is no reduction in the course fees where a course includes a public holiday.

[2] We adhere to the published age limits for courses, but reserve the right to accept students who are outside the published age limit on the General English course, either when travelling as part of a group with a leader in attendance, or when living with a parent or guardian in the UK.

[3] The General English and Beginners maximum class size is 16 students in July and August.

[4] In very rare circumstances, the maximum stated class size may be exceeded but this would only be by a maximum of one student for one week.
